This course describes how organizations can implement an **integrated management system** (IMS) combining all related components of business into **one system** for easier management and operations.

The idea behind implementing an **integrated management system** (IMS) is that Quality (QMS), Environment (EMS), and Safety (OHS) management systems are often combined and managed as an IMS.

Processes are seamlessly managed, and efficiently executed because of avoiding costly duplication. IMS components are shared to all the systems including resources (people, facilities, equipments, ...) and processes (documented in the QMS/EMS/OHS and applied throughout the organization)
